DESCRIPTION:

Our annual virtual academic conference is a new type of conference made for ALL Ancient Studies scholars and anyone interested in the ancient world. This is a completely virtual conference which is free to the public!

The theme this year is: Representations of the Past in Ancient and Modern Times! Some studies deal with how past societies perceived and represented their pasts, but are often focused on the tradition of ancient historians and historiography both in the ancient and modern world. But what knowledge did ancient peoples have of their own deep pasts? This interdisciplinary conference examines the exploration, representation, and reception of pasts in the broadest cross-cultural, global, and atemporal world context.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We will accept abstracts from anyone who believes they are qualified to present! In particular, we encourage submissions from nontraditional scholars who normally do not have the opportunity to present and engage with scholarship. Examples include undergraduate/graduate students, K-12 teachers, cultural resource management professionals, people with ancient studies backgrounds who pursue unrelated professions, and independent scholars.

HOW TO SUBMIT

Materials:

- abstract of no more than 300 words (plus bibliography)
- statement of interest, no more than 200 words
- resume or CV as appropriate
- short bio including name, pronouns, and current work
